New to Zoom? Here's what you need to know

Zoom is pretty easy to set up and use. If you are using a tablet or smartphone (iPad or Android) there are apps to use. You should be able to find the app "Zoom" in your App Store.

If you are using your computer (ideally with a camera, like most laptops have) when you click on the link from your

weekly church email, it will take you to a website and ask to install Zoom on your computer. Say "yes". It is a very small and pretty quick download and install.

Once installed, whenever you click on a zoom link it will automatically launch zoom and log you into the meeting. If it doesn't log you into the meeting automatically, you can manually type in the meeting ID into the Zoom app (on computer, smartphone, or tablet) and then the password, and it will take you to the meeting.

'Llama Pajama Time with Andrea'

'Llama Pajama Time with Andrea' is now on **Saturdays at 9:30 am**. for you to get involved in the upcoming year.

CHURCH COUNCIL, which is our governing body, has 3 open positions starting in July.

- **Treasurer** The Treasurer is responsible for the care of the funds and financial records of the church and reporting the church's financial activities and financial condition.
- **Member-at-large** This person is usually not on a ministry team and represents the membership of our church on the church council.
- Auditor The Auditor is a member of the church who is a qualified accountant and does not hold any other elected office in the church. An annual audit of the financial records of the church is prepared by the Auditor.

In addition, we have three **MINISTRY TEAMS** that need your support also starting in July.

- We need 5 people to join the Membership Ministry Team which seeks to make individuals welcome in our church community. They welcome visitors, new members, and work with ministry teams to encourage member participation in ministry teams and church council.
- We need **3** people to join the **Stewardship Ministry Team** which encourages giving of one's self to God's work. They currently focus most of their work on planning and organizing for Consecration Sunday.
- We need **4** people to join the **Finance Ministry Team** which manages the financial affairs of the church including the annual budgeting.

It's not too late to participate in the online 'march' for climate action

Your Mission and Justice team invites everyone to **make a sign** and join Interfaith Power and Light's online 'Love Made Visible Climate March'.

Due to the current conditions, IPL won't be hosting a real march but instead invites you to make and then share a climate march sign **on social media** during **Faith Climate Action Week April 17th** – **26th** to continue bringing awareness to the climate crisis. The theme is "*Love Made Visible: Engaging in Sacred Activism*" to protect the people we love who are most impacted by climate change. People are more vulnerable to COVID-19 in communities where there are high levels of air pollution caused by the burning of fossil fuels. We need to continue to fight for clean air especially in light of the present pandemic. Your Mission and Justice team is asking



you to take part in this virtual march by making your own sign based on this year's theme, then take a picture of you or someone else holding the sign, and send it to the church office <u>office@bccucc.org</u> for posting on the church's Facebook page during this time (April 17th - 26th). You are also encouraged to post it on your own Social Media! IPL has a suggested sign where you fill in the blank – saying

"For Love of *(blank)* I stand for Climate Justice. #FaithClimateActionWeek" Fill in the blank with words such as: Children, Youth, Those Not Yet Born, Our Neighbors, God's Creation, Each Other, Our Families, This World, etc. You can either make your own sign, or download one (with a space to fill in the blank) at www.faithclimateactionweek.org/join-ipls-love-made-visible-climate-march-online.
