
Welcome to Worship

INVITATION

PROMISES TO GOD AND ONE ANOTHER

<u>Minister</u>: A covenant is integral to relationships with God, so today we state the responsibilities of parents and community to God and child. Kyle and Kelsey, I ask you now to affirm your covenant with God and Keegan.

<u>To the Parents:</u> Do you promise, to the best of your ability and with God helping you, that you will love Keegan and give to him all that you can so that he will grow to the fullness of life that God intends?

The Minister, Family, God-Guys, and Deacon lay hands on the child.

<u>Minister</u>: Keegan Duke, may the Holy Spirit work within you that being born in the Spirit you may become a faithful disciple of Jesus Christ. Amen.

PRESENTATION AND WELCOME

The Minister walks the child out into the congregation sharing words of faith.

<u>Congregation</u>: Gracious God, giver of life, you have called us by name and pledged to each of us your faithful love. We pray today for your blessings on Keegan, that you will watch over him and guide him as he grows in faith. Remind us of your promises of our own baptism and renew our trust in you. Make us strong to obey your will and to serve you with joy, through the power of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

The Minister and Deacon present the family with the Baptismal Certificate and rose and offer the right hand of fellowship.
