# Please attend this important church meeting

## New update from the GMTF

The Governance and Ministry Task Force is excited for our **congregational meeting** on **Sunday**, **January 28** to be held in the sanctuary immediately following the worship service. At that meeting the church will vote on:

- our new church by-laws,
- a slate of nominations for positions in the new church structure,
- the 2024 church budget.



The Finance Team is putting together the final pieces of the budget and plans to have that available ahead of the meeting.

The draft of the proposed 2024 By-Laws is already available on a <u>special website dedicated to</u> <u>the new structure</u>, which can also be accessed from the news page of the church website <u>www.bccucc.org/news/</u>.

Lastly, nominating is going really well and we are finalizing our last two positions. That information will be made available as soon as it is completed.

By the end of next week, ahead of the congregational meeting, **an email will be sent to the congregation** containing links to all of the items up for vote: the proposed budget, the list of nominees, and the draft by-laws. All church members are encouraged to attend this important meeting (official warrant is below) and child care will be provided.

We recently received a letter from St. Pauly Textile Inc, the organization that installed and collects the items left in the clothing shed in our parking lot. They let us know that our shed collected 56,224 pounds of clothing in 2023 which is







enough to clothe an estimated 10,357 people all over the world. Based on this volume of clothing, the church received payment of \$2,249.

Thanks to all who use the shed, with special thanks to Jay Buckley, Frank and Barbara Lee, and Pat Stoddard who regularly move the bags from where they land inside the shed below the drop slot, and stack them up against the walls, making room for more donations.

CCUCC continues the collection of food bags to be given to the families of 25 students at DelSesto Middle School in Providence who are experiencing food insecurity. We continue to partner with *We Share Hope* (<u>https://wesharehope.org</u>) to provide food to those in need & also with *Books are Wings* who donate free books for the students. BCCUCC supplements the food donations to fill the bags. We collect the following items in the box in the narthex as you go up the stairs to church: **peanut butter, bread, jelly, oatmeal, canned tuna, rice and beans, pasta and sauce, fruit cups, granola bars and shelf stable pudding**. Thank you to those who supported December's collection.
