TAPIN Thanksgiving Food Collection

We are again joining with other houses of worship in town to help provide the food that is given away to those in need in the TAPIN Thanksgiving Food bags. This year our congregation is being asked to donate **Stuffing Mix**,



Cranberry Sauce, and Gravy. (Please note that TAPIN is not allowed to split up large boxes of items purchased from BJ's etc – they can only give out the regular packaged boxes.) TAPIN helps about 350 families in the East Bay area each Thanksgiving so lots is needed! Food donations may be placed in the bins in the narthex (on your way into church) or in the one near the stage in Fellowship Hall. TAPIN also accepts monetary donations for the purchase of gift cards which they can buy in bulk at a discount. (Checks can be made payable to 'BCCUCC' with 'TAPIN' in the memo line.) **Donations will be collected again on November 10th & 17th.** Deadline for delivery of items to TAPIN is Mon, Nov 18th.


