Fellowship Hall Arch Project

As many of you know we have been running a small capital campaign to perform essential structural repairs on the arches in Fellowship Hall. The cost of the project is approximately \$30,000. Thanks to tremendous support from our lead givers as well as additional support from so many other families in the church, we are nearly at our goal. We are



presently at \$29,000! That is excellent. For those who have already given, thank you. For those who have pledged, and not yet sent in your contribution, thank you and please send it in soon. For others, it's not too late to join the team. We can raise this last \$1000 (or more) and then celebrate. If you would like to learn more about the project or to see the work that will be done, look for the yellow "caution" tape in the hall and reach out to Paul Dennis or Rev. Dale Azevedo. Construction is set to begin on January 6 and last for approximately 2-4 weeks. During that time the hall with have no or very limited use. Once again, thanks for your support!
