


how we as a church are moving forward as we try to answer it. He also gives a behind the scenes look at what - and who - is involved in putting together the Sunday virtual

Our church's Annual Meeting will take place on **Sunday, June 7th** immediately following the 10 am worship service. This year it will take place virtually via Zoom (login information will be included later). In addition to the regular business of the meeting, we will be voting on a slate of nominees for a Search Committee for a new Associate Minister for Congregational Life. There will also be a report from the Vision 2020 and Beyond Team. All church

R.I.P. Medical Debt Update

Another huge thank you to all who helped the Mission and Justice Team reach their \$4000.00 goal for R.I.P. Medical Debt. As of May 15th, the Southern New England Conference has reported a total of \$138,894.20 which will eliminate 13.8 million dollars of debt in the three states that make up our Conference. Individuals who qualify for this debt relief must meet three criteria.



- Earn less than 2x the federal level (varies by state, family size)
- Debts are 5 percent or more of annual income
- Facing insolvency debts are greater than assets

Earth Day Forever Stamps

The Earth Day Network is reminding us that we can now buy

the Earth Day Forever stamp to continue our celebration of Earth Day's 50th anniversary on April 22, 2020:

<u>Support the U.S. Postal Service and our essential U.S. postal workers by ordering the Earth Day stamp.</u> Or buy them at your local post office.

Use the Earth Day Forever stamp whenever you send mail. You'll also be raising awareness about our environment.

The Earth Day Forever stamp features USPS Stamp Development Art Director Antonio Alcalá's painting of Earth

with small green lines surrounding the planet, rendered in gouache (a type of watercolor using opaque paint) on watercolor paper.

These are Forever stamps, staying current even if postal rates go up, because Earth Day will always be Every Day.



New to Zoom? Here's what you need to know

Zoom is pretty easy to set up and use. If you are using a tablet or smartphone (iPad or Android) there are apps to use. You should be able to find the app "Zoom" in your App Store.

If you are using your computer (ideally with a camera, like most laptops have) when you click on the link from your weekly church



email, it will take you to a website and ask to install Zoom on your computer. Say "yes".

It is a very small and pretty quick download and install.

Once installed, whenever you click on a zoom link it will automatically launch zoom and log you into the meeting. If it doesn't log you into the meeting automatically, you can manually type in the meeting ID into the Zoom app (on computer, smartphone, or tablet) and then the password, and it will take you to the meeting.
