Worshipping from the sanctuary again - despite some technical issues!

What a great Sunday we had last week! June 27th marked the first multi-platform worship service at BCCUCC. While it was great to have 71 people in worship and at least another 35 families joining us online, it was not without it challenges.

If you tried to join us through Facebook Live, we apologize for it not working. For those who were able to join us through YouTube and/or the website, we are sorry for the delay. This was our first experiment and we only had two days following the install to prepare. Not only that, the installation wasn't complete! So, for those who joined us live or online, and for those who tried to join us but couldn't, THANK YOU!



The installation company is doing more work on the system this week and we're sure this Sunday's service will go more smoothly on both platforms. We will continue to work out the kinks as we go forward. Thanks for your patience and support!

We look forward to you joining us again for worship - whether in person or online.

Multi-platform Worship at 9:30 am every Sunday

All are invited to join us for our **multi-platform worship service** at **9:30 a.m.** during the summer. We're very hopeful that the technical problems experienced last Sunday will have been fully resolved in time for this week's service (*see above*).



For those attending in person, we still need to take precautions to provide the safest conditions possible for everyone, and so there are **guidelines** in place. If you plan to worship with us in person in the sanctuary we ask that you read them ahead of time. Of particular note is that we're asking everyone, regardless of their vaccination status, to wear a mask. This is particularly important to keep our children safe as they haven't had the opportunity to be vaccinated yet. Thank you.

July 4th is Communion Sunday

It is our tradition on the first Sunday of every month to do two things: celebrate Communion and have Deacons Fund envelopes in the bulletin so the congregation can make donations.

COMMUNION: For those who attend worship in person, the deacons will be serving individual pre-packaged communion that is gluten free - or you can bring your own elements if you prefer. If you're worshiping with us online, we invite you to have elements on hand so you can join in this celebration. It doesn't have to be bread and juice (or even wine) - whatever you have on hand will do.
