You can make a difference!

The Juarez family have arrived!

At 4 am on Thursday, August 8th, the Juarez family from Mexico arrived at the home of Lory and Charlie McCoy, where they'll be living while they legally seek asylum here in the US. They'd landed a couple of hours earlier in Providence, having been delayed due to both weather and immigration, on their flights from El Paso, Texas. The mother, Estrelle, and her daughters Genesis, Angie and Azul are very happy to be here. They attended the worship service last Sunday with Lory and Bridgett McCoy, and were introduced to the BCCUCC family.



Estrelle and her daughters arrived here with everything they owned contained in 2 backpacks and 2 small holdalls (see photo) and they'll need a lot of assistance as they transition to RI. Lory has already helped them register the children in school and the family with various agencies. While the McCoys will be providing for many of their needs, they're also looking for additional assistance from the congregation. The most pressing needs are for monetary donations (so they can buy clothes and other essential items); 2 bikes (suitable for people 5' to 5' 3" tall); and transportation to and from ICE visits and English lessons. Lory has set up a bank account for the family, but because they don't have social security numbers, it is currently in Lory's name. Anyone wishing to make a donation is invited to write checks payable to 'Lory McCoy' with 'Juarez family' in the memo line. Checks can be put in the offering plate, sent to the church office, or mailed/given directly to Lory. Gift cards to stores like Target and WalMart would also be appreciated. (You can purchase them online and have them emailed directly to <u>lsnadymccov@gmail.com</u>, or purchase them locally to give to Lory, or drop them off at the church office).


