Guest Preacher - Rev Jim Antal

We hope you can join us for worship **this Sunday**, **January 24th** when the Rev. Jim Antal will be our guest preacher. Jim is the former Conference Minister of the Massachusetts Conference of the UCC and is a well-known advocate for climate justice and its intersection with faith. He is the author of the recently released book *Climate Church, Climate World*.

About his new book, Archbishop Desmond Tutu writes, "Jim Antal shows how the church can engage the urgent moral crisis of climate change. This book will inspire both the courage and conviction people of

faith need to provide the leadership necessary to realise [sic] God's dream of a just world in which humanity is reconciled to all of creation."

There will be a follow up virtual Q&A with Jim at a later date, and also a possible adult discussion class/study. <u>Learn more</u>
